PROGRAM

Our speaker was Patti Zingaro. She and her husband lost a teen to suicide. She represents the Second Wind Foundation which was started 5 years ago. Green Mt. HS in conjunction with the Green Mt. Presb. Church fosters suicide prevention in our local and state high schools. They have a 3 mile walk/run fund raiser which will take place on Sep. 23 at 12:30 for \$25. Last year they had 1900 participants. The money raised goes to reduced rate counseling for from 8 to 20 sessions for teens at risk, who have been referred.

Teen suicide is the second leading cause of death among teens in the US. Over the last 5 years there have been 650-700 referrals. CO is 6th in the nation in teen deaths to suicide. Wheat Ridge HS had 44 referrals last year. Recommended kids can be put into counseling the same day. 50 councilors are available.

No one has died after being referred to a councilor. \$104K was raised last year. www.secondwindfund.org.
