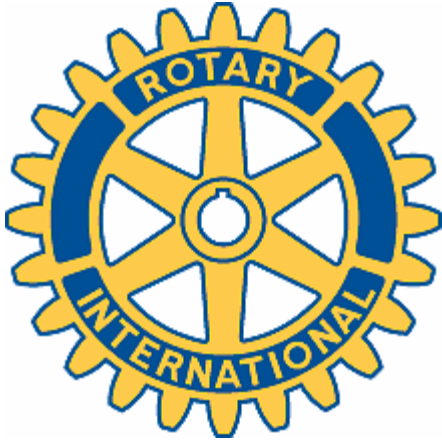

The program this evening was Bob Bruner, retired from US West and At&T, now a volunteer at the Denver Museum of Nature and Science. The Constellations and Greek Mythology!!!

His story all started with a painting Louis XV had on the ceiling in Versailles ...next thing you know we were told the origins of 12 constellations.....There are 88 constellations in total, a Homeric tale of each gives us the names we know....

Cignas the Swan, Gemini the twins, Taurus the Bull, the Bears Ursa Major and Ursa Minor....the Tip of the tail is the North Star, Perius the Hero, Hercules, Leo the Lion, Hydra the Snake, Cancer the Crab and Drago the Dragon.

The principal characters in this all are Zeus and his wife Herra, with their daughter, Hebe the Goddess of Youth, who married Hercules. The tail spins it's way through Zeus'

many dalliances which cause the creation of many of the constellations!
