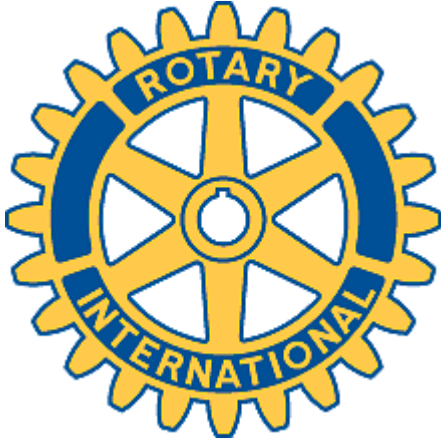

Both Stormy and Bruce are members of the Peace Corp for people over 50. The mission of the Peace Corp is to take two years and help somewhere in the developing world. Also share learned cultures with others in other countries.

There are 8,000 in the Peace Corps. More than half are women. The average age is 27 and the oldest in service is 80. Of 139 countries, 73 have P/C members serving there. The host country MUST invite the P/C in to help in their country.

What programs do the P/C volunteers help in?

35% in education

21% in health and HIVAIDS

15% in business development

14% in environmental

5% in agriculture

P/C workers live with a host country family and enjoy adventure, job experience a monthly living allowance, medical and dental coverage, and 48 days vacation.
