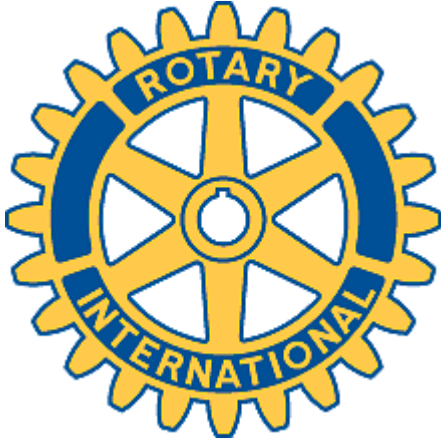

PROGRAM

Our speaker for the evening was Jamie Corbin who has been to Uganda 3 times to work on a residence and school for orphans there.

Jamie met a woman named Juliette who is from Uganda and is in the U.S. finishing her schooling and she has been able to obtain a large monetary gift with which she bought 70 acres southeast of the capitol Kampala. This is where the residence and school are being built. Right now 6 of the 7 residence houses are complete and they’re working on the school.

There are 70 orphans in the program both single and double orphans mostly because of AIDES. Their ages range form 8 to 15. They have started a 20-person choir, which has made a CD, and they are planning a 6-month tour of the US to promote the CD and raise money for their building program.
