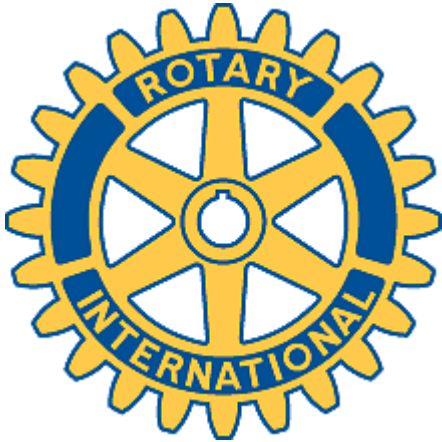

## **PROGRAM**

## "The Joy of Living"

Our speaker this evening was Caroline Fricky of the Hospice at Lutheran Medical Center, The Collier Hospice Center. The new hospice building was completed in 2006 and opened to the public.

Caroline has been a nurse for 32 years and the past several with the Hospice, which she says has made her form the philosophy of "how do you want to live near the end of your life?" A question of those with terminal illness and their families.

Hospice's are relatively new to health care, the first opened in England in 1964, and the first in the U.S. in 1972. Typically the patient has 6 months or less to live, they must be referred by 2 physicians. Not all hospices' are in buildings, many patients prefer to stay at home, and hospice care is provided by the hospice program. "Hospice is a philosophy", wherever home is for you, hospice will be there.

Funding for these programs come from Medicare, some private insurance companies, foundations raising funds and other gifts.

(We have a Great Hospice organization here in Evergreen Mt. Evans Hospice and Home Health Care, is a group we have supported over the years)
