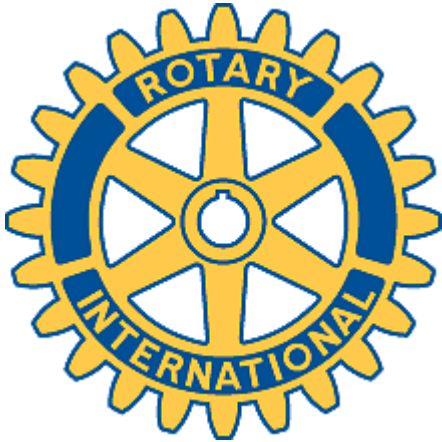

Sandy Jones, "Horses Helping Humans"

Sandy and her husband are new to the Evergreen, moved here a year ago. She had retired as a teacher, but realized she wanted to be involved, her love of horses led her to start 3H Ranch. Their desire to help with special needs children and adults, horse therapy dates back to 460 BC. Currently there are 800 programs in the US with 22 in Colorado.

The three dimensional movement riders experience on a horse provides balance, strength, and confidence for them. This Equitherapy, between horse and human allows the coping with handicapping conditions for humans and rescued horses too.

Sandy believes the horse is the bridge from "I can't" to "I can" and the rescued horses there will know what it means to begin again!
