PROGRAM

Tom Picarelli.....Indian perceptions; Indian Law & Policy; Trust Responsibility of the Government; & Dpet. Of Interior- Minerals Management

Tom is a hands on person, his insight with Indians was unique for us to hear. The term Native American was first used in 1960 and despite some beliefs there si no set criteria for establishing lineage. It seems each tribe, branch of tribe can use different criteria. There are 278 reservations in the US and most of the Indians live on them, the largest is the Navajo reservation of new Mexico, Colorado and Arizona.

The Trust Responsibility of the US Government began in the 1830's; Indian law & Policy began with US troops moving the Indians around where the government thought best....naturally later administrations moved them again when gold or items were need from the land. It should be mentioned that the reservations are sovereign, their law is supreme, even down to speeding tickets!

The Dawes Act allowed for the head of each Indian family to receive 160 acres of land, with other family members 80 to get them to assimilate into society.
