SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT:

As you may recall we have been participating in the Dollywood Reading Program for Children from birth through age 5....each month a book is sent to a sponsored child to be read by family. The Evergreen club and Peak To Peak have participated also. We have been administering the grant for this program, but have been approached by Evergreen to have them do it. They currently have 100 children in the program, we have 9 and Peak To Peak 4.

The invoices are received each month by Evergreen Rotary (Brenda Hagerman) via e-mail. Three Excel spreadsheet reports are updated by Evergreen (one for each club) with

the details provided on the invoice, breaking the numbers down by the kids sponsored by the three clubs. Copies of the invoice and the reports are sent to Mountain Foothills and Peak-to-Peak each month.

If this proposal is accepted, it is believed the flow of the paperwork and funds would be greatly simplified as a single point person would have all the information at hand for record keeping, prompt payments, and communication between Dollywood and the three Rotary clubs.

We hear about it everyday, identity theft...well just think Peggy told us that 1 in 3 people, will be affected by identity theft in the next 3 months...and it takes about 600 hours of your time to fix the problem.

There are basically five types of identity theft, 1. Financial; 2. Criminal; 3. Medical; 4. Social Security; and 5. Drivers License. An example....400,000 people in the past few years have new jobs, but according to their social Security numbers are no longer living.

According to Peggy the Best protection is to have your credit monitored 24/7 by a provider and to have Full Restoration coverage.providing restoration of your name and your credit.
