Currently they are teaching the local women how to clean the water filters on their wells and home water supplies and how to teach others to do this too. They are planning 12 – 20 new wells in a 19 village area. They are asking our club to become involved with this water project. Haiti had beautiful stands of mahogany trees which were sadly clear cut to be used for charcoal and some was sent to other countries for furniture wood. A reforestation project is in the works to provide trees for shade and increased water supply. More on this later.
