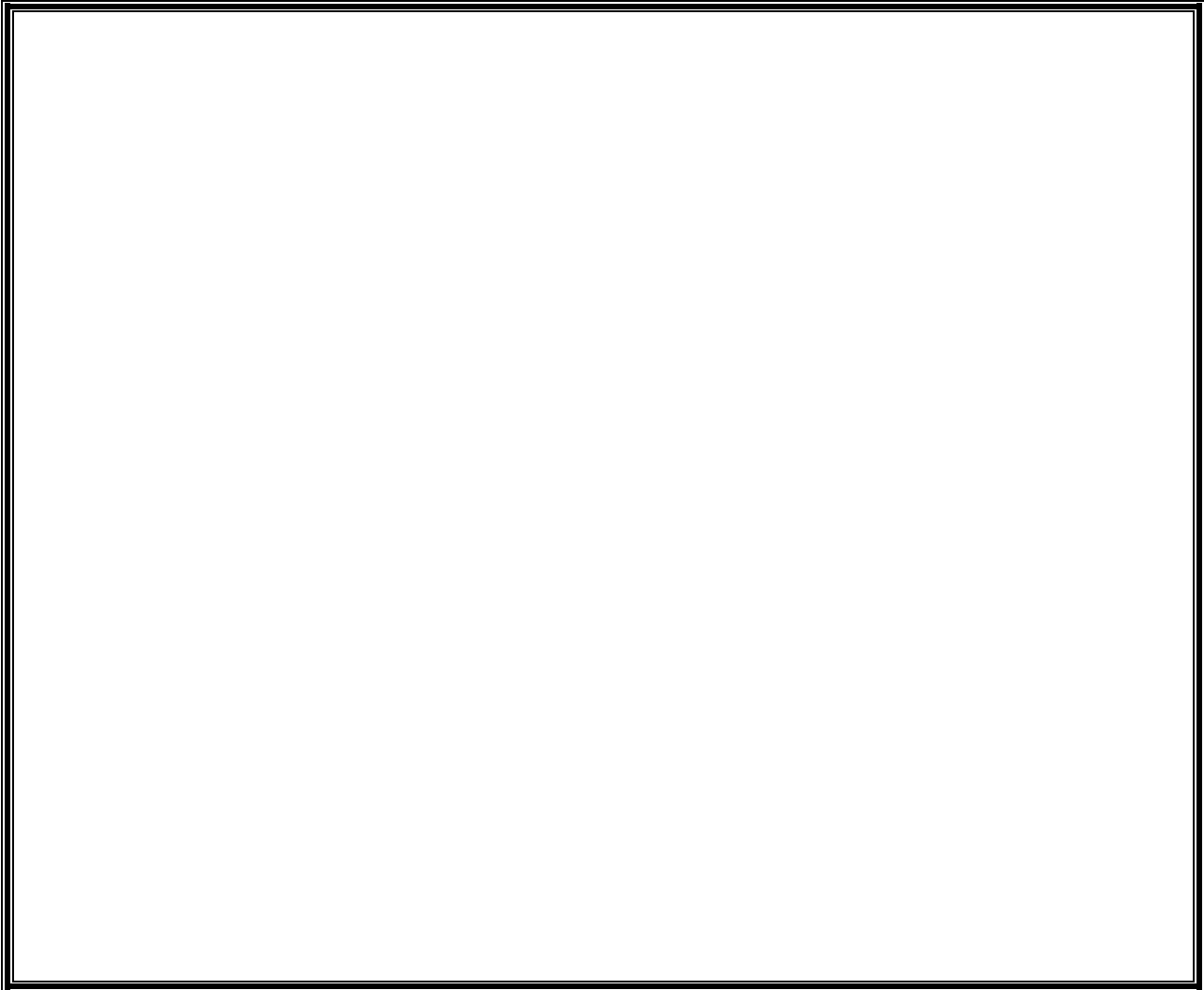
**Nov. 5<sup>th</sup>** Club Assembly, we will also have our Young RYLA students with us.
