I'll send a separate update from Dave, he truly does wonderful work and lives the Rotary Motto....Service Above Self.

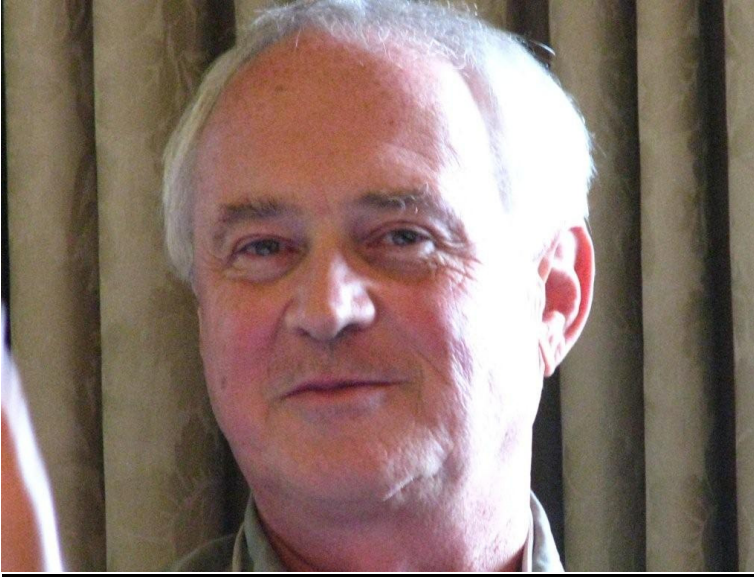
