Myron is a Rotarian with the Westminster Club, past president there and is active with Rotary International. Myron shared some interesting employment statistics with us.....

In the..... 70's we had 78.6 million workers in the US

..... 2000, there were 136.9 million growing to 146 million in 2008.

As of December 08 US unemployment was 7.2%, in Colorado it was 6.1%.....for every 1% increase in unemployment equals 1.6 million workers.....that same 1% decreases our GNP (Gross National Product=the sum of the goods and services produced in the country) by \$300 Billion.

Myron talked about some generational differences:

Traditionalists, born before 1945 believe in top down management

Boomers, born between 1945-63 are optimists, individualism

Gen-Xer's, born 1964-78 are independent, 2-income families

Gen-Yer's, born 1979-94 are optimistic

As a Businessman and Rotarian he ended with The 4-Way Test!!!
