"Young Life" Ministers to Youth

Brian is the Great Grandson of the founder of Phillips petroleum, now
Conoco-Phillips. He joined the organization in 1998 with a desire to
help "unchurched" youth. From his experience over the years he
discovered it takes at least 2 years to win the trust of some kids. It

The Young Life program was founded in 1940 and is now in 50 countries. They market their programs, especially retreats at their 20 camps across the nation. They have 3 in Colorado.

The ministry is done outside of schools and focused on what they call the 4-C's.....**Contact**, finding youth at parks, sporting events, clubs, concerts; **Club**, offer meetings for them if they desire...such as here in Evergreen with the Breakfast Club a few years ago started by Ben McComb; **Camp**, with programs a week; and **Campaigners**, offering bible study.
