Lisa Monette knew she wanted to do something for her class project that would have a lasting impact.

Monette, a [Rotary World Peace Fellow](#) at Chulalongkorn University, joined forces with three other peace fellows who were thinking along similar lines. Together, they dreamed up A Million Acts of Peace, an effort they launched online 27 August to encourage one million people to carry out one act of peace each.

"The idea sort of grew out of the thought that people can do little things that may not mean that much," Monette says. "But if you have a million people doing little things, you can have a big impact."

Laura (Shephard) Churchley
"Alan Shepard—Daddy"

The U.S. Space program officially announced its first team of astronauts in April 1959, the original 7, included Alan Shepard. At the time Laura was in the 7th grade...her Dad came home and said he had a new job, that "...NASA would put me in a capsule, blast me into space, and I will return safely...." Of course Laura and her sisters didn't think anything of it, after all her dad was a test pilot.

As we recall Alan Shepard was the first American in space on May 5, 1961 in Freedom 7. Alan made his second space flight as spacecraft commander on Apollo 14, January 31 - February 9, 1971.....he was the 5th to walk on the Moon.

Laura has met Presidents Kenney. Johnson, Nixon, Ford and Carter. As well as many rock stars and race car drivers. In December 2006 the USNS Alan B. Shepard was commissioned by Laura and one of her sisters, it is a munitions supply ship that Laura visited for two days as it resupplied a Carrier in the Pacific.

Laura ended her comments by saying...."Daddy was standing on the moon. How many of us can say that?...."
