Retired FBI agent Richard Schussler told us about some of the more famous cases on which he worked. He was dispatched to oversee the legal aspects and conduct interviews of Terry Nichols in the Oklahoma City bombing case. The evidence was overwhelming against the bombers. Richard quipped that when he mentions the Patty Hearst brainwashing case on which he also worked, his students, look at him with wonder asking, "who is Patty Hearst."

In addition to teaching, Richard participates with other retired law enforcement officers as a consultant for the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children, as a member of Team Adam. He still does some contract work for the FBI.
